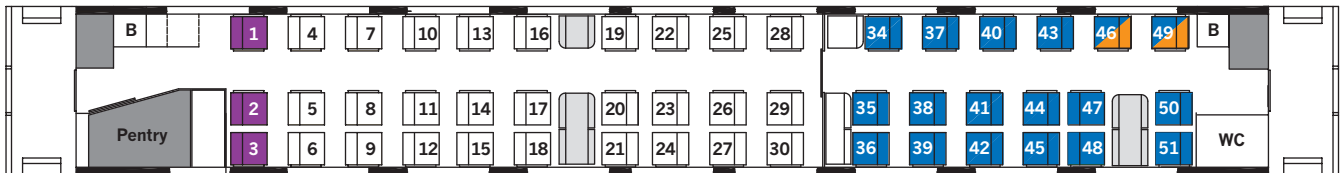
Southbound trains – carriage 1 is at the front and carriage 7 is at the back. Northbound trains – carriage 7 is at the front and carriage 1 is at the back.

Trains to Jönköping, arriving from Stockholm (or opposite direction), change direction in Nässjö. If you travel facing forwards from Stockholm/Jönköping, you will travel facing backwards for the remainder of your journey after Nässjö. If you travel facing backwards from Stockholm/Jönköping, you will travel facing forwards for the remainder of your journey after Nässjö.

Carriages 1 and 2 1st Class | 48 seats | There may be guide and service dogs by the disabled seats.

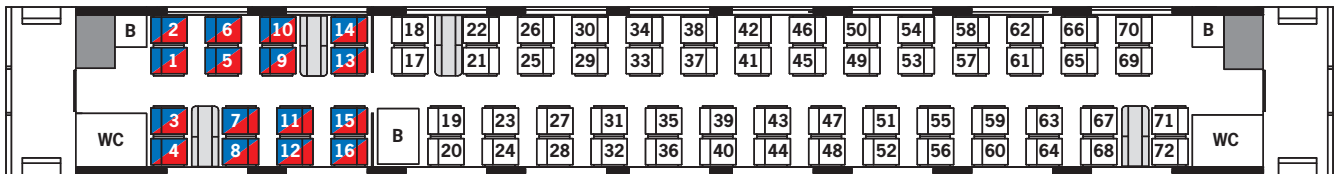

Carriages 3, 4 and 6 2nd Class | 72 seats.

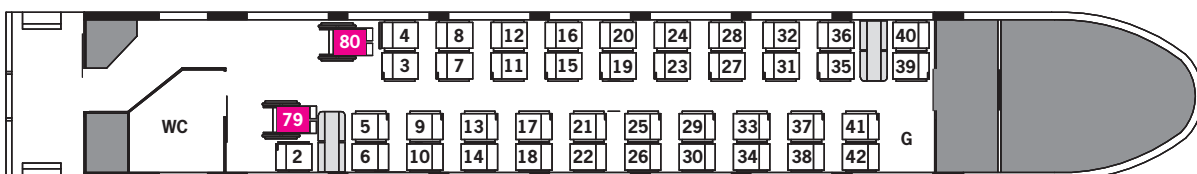

Carriage 7 2nd Class | 41 seats + 2 wheelchair places | There may be guide and service dogs by the disabled seats.

Seat close to wheelchair space: 5 – 6, 9 – 10



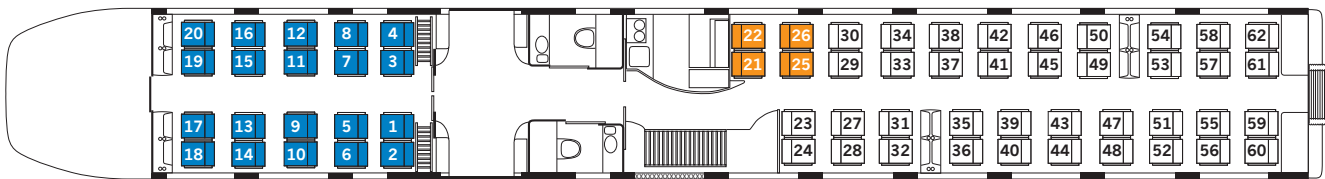
Overview SJ 3000

Southbound trains operate with carriage 1 at the front and carriage 4 at the back. Northbound trains operate with carriage 4 at the front and carriage 1 at the back. The reverse applies on trains on the Göteborg – Malmö – Göteborg route, i.e. trains bound for Malmö operate with carriage 4 at the front and carriage 1 at the back while trains bound for Göteborg operate with carriage 1 at the front and carriage 4 at the back.

On Stockholm – Karlstad – Stockholm route applies the following: trains bound for Karlstad operate with carriage 1 at the front and carriage 4 at the back and trains bound for Stockholm operate with carriage 4 at the front and carriage 1 at the back.

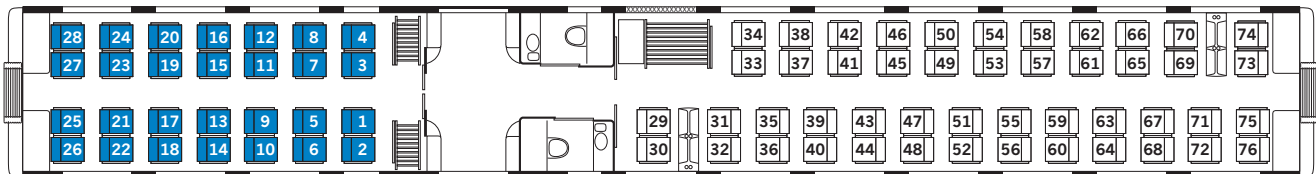
Trains to Uddevalla, arriving from Stockholm (or opposite direction), change direction in Herrljunga. If you travel, facing forwards from Stockholm/Uddevalla, you will travel facing backwards for the remainder of your journey after Herrljunga. If you travel facing backwards from Stockholm/Uddevalla, you will travel facing forwards for the remainder of your journey after Herrljunga.

Carriage 1 1st Class



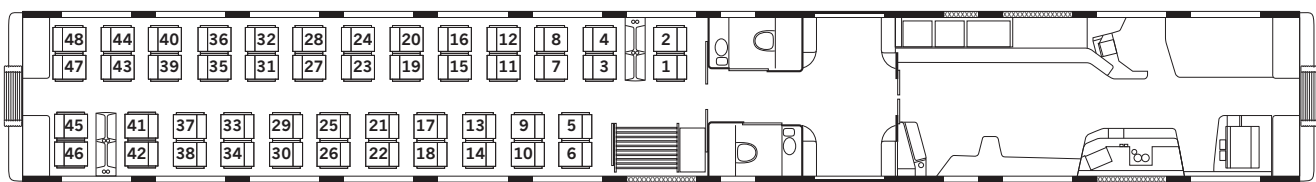
Disabled seat: 21, 22, 25 and 26 Quiet zone: 1 – 20

Carriage 2 2nd Class



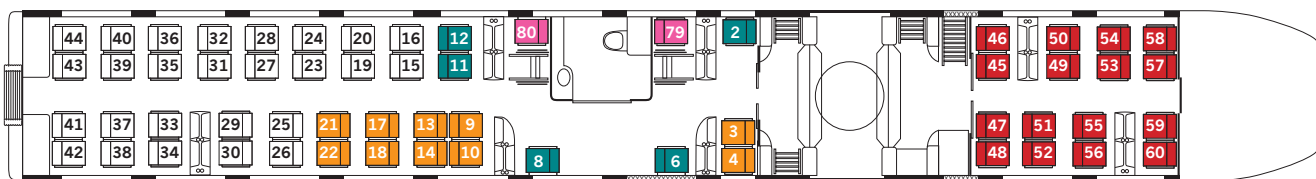
